Public Meeting

Date: Monday the 9th of Jan 2012 **Start:** 7.30pm

Venue: Memorial Hall, Main Street, Addingham

Purpose: The purpose of this public meeting is to provide an opportunity for the villagers of Addingham to comment upon the Bradford MDC Local Development Framework (LDF) proposals for new housing in Addingham up to the year 2028.

- This meeting is being held to allow people to comment upon the LDF proposals.
- The meeting is not a debate nor is it a question and answer session.
- Anyone wishing to speak should provide their full name and address, before commenting.
- All comments will be minuted and will provide the basis for the Civic Society's response.
- The Civic Society will not be giving its views on the proposals, in the meeting.
- The Civic Society will provide a summary of the meeting in its February newsletter and via email. Non-members who have requested regular updates will be emailed.
- The Ilkley Gazette will be publishing a summary of the meeting as well.

The meeting will invite comments on three principal issues/topics:

1. Housing and the Environment: New Housing, Proposed Locations, The Green Belt, Affordable and Social Housing, The impact on the Environment

2. Transport and Services: Roads and traffic, Village parking, Travel to work/school, Rail and bus services, Education inc schools, school places, locations, GP places, Health and care facilities

3. Economy and jobs: Tourism and visitors, Culture and heritage, Business services, Rails links to Leeds and Bradford, Jobs and Office space.

- The totality of the comments of the people of Addingham will be fed into the Bradford MDC LDF consultation by the Civic Society no later than the deadline of Friday the 20th of Jan 2012.
